




## Element # 2 of the system Sender

## Structure of the **Thesis Statements** Topic + Comment.

Subject of the main verb

The remaining parts of the sentence ..O-...-C... (predicate)

#### The Thesis Statement (TS)

- Every writing should have a central idea or central message
- TS One or two sentences
- TS Serves as a summary of the message
- Thesis statement for a text (several paragraphs)
- Topic statement for a paragraph
- Thesis statement > Topic statement and is more general

#### An Example

Speaking and writing are not identical. Writing is not simply speech written down on paper. Learning to write is not just a natural extension of learning to speak a language. We learned to speak our first language at home without systematic instruction; whereas, most of us had to be taught in school how to write that same language. Many adult native speakers of a language find writing difficult. A speaker speaks to a listener who is right there, nodding or frowning, or interrupting or questioning. For the writer, the reader's response is either delayed or nonexistent.

#### The Thesis Statement

- Indicates scope, purpose, and direction of writing
- Sets up/Identifies relationships between all parts of the message
- Is a road map for the message
- Directly answers essential questions about the message M.

## Further Properties of the Thesis Statement

- Should be concise and well written
- Should be specific
- Should be general & needs support
- Should initiate the "what" question
   & the "why" question.

#### **Further Tips**

- Not all texts require thesis statements!
- Thesis statements are not statements of <u>fact</u>: aluminum is lighter than iron.
- Thesis statements are not statements of <u>opinion</u>: "I think that volume of sales is simply the result of the price of the commodity."

## Tips for Writing Good Thesis Statements

- Avoid burying the thesis statement in the middle.
- Avoid vague words.
- Connect two large statements to signal relationship:
  - by conjunction (but, for, so, yet) or (though, because, if, when, While, ...)

Tying all paragraphs (case of thesis statement)

Tying all sentences (case of topic statement)

#### TS: to test cohesion of the paragraph

## Before Writing the Text/Paragraph, build the Thesis/Topic Statement.

#### **How To Build?**

- 1- Identify keywords (KW)
- 2- Group KW
- 3- Cast KW into TS structure.
